As the second oldest university in Hong Kong, CUHK is a comprehensive research university with a global vision and mission to combine tradition with modernity, and to bring together China and the West. Hong Kong is a relatively small city conveniently connected by a subway and train system which is always on time. The campus, which overlooks the scenic Tolo Harbour and is surrounded by greenery, has grown over the years to become the city's largest, greenest, and most sustainably designed campus.

INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL



Established in 2004, the CUHK International Summer School (ISS) has been one of the most popular undergraduate summer programmes in the region. Each year, numerous international and local students join the July and August Sessions of the ISS to experience its intensive academic sessions and Chinese culture immersion in a multicultural learning environment. This is a great opportunity for you to gain a Hong Kong and Asian perspective from your peers and to explore Chinese culture through classroom learning, activities and field trips.

# July Session

#### 23 June - 31 July

In the five-week programme, you can take up to two 3-credit courses, each with 42 contact hours, taught entirely in English. Areas of study include:

- Environment, Science and Technology
- Global Business and Management
- $\cdot$  Society and Human Interaction
- Understanding China
- Chinese Language
- (Putonghua and Cantonese)

## August Session

#### 4 - 24 August

In the 3-week programme, you will take two 3-credit courses of intensive Chinese language training in Putonghua at various levels of proficiency. The programme will provide an opportunity for you to acquire pragmatic competence in the Chinese language through classroom learning and immersion activities.

### Exploring Hong Kong: From Preservation of Cultural Heritage to Fostering Creativity in Urban Landscapes
