

Letter of Undertaking for Student Visa Application

(Applicable to students providing parent's financial declaration)

Referring to page 3 of the Application Form ID 995A (Application for Entry for Study in Hong Kong) under item 7 'Financial Situation of Applicant', you are required to provide your own financial declaration (<u>OR</u> your parent's financial declaration if you do not have one) to the Hong Kong Immigration Department for consideration. <u>If your parent is your financial sponsor</u>, s/he is required to submit the following **THREE** documents to the Hong Kong Immigration Department c/o Office of Summer Programmes (OSP) along with your student visa application forms.

- 1. Letter of Undertaking (completed and signed by parent)
- 2. Photocopies of Financial Declaration (see below for specification)

(2a)	Recent financial declaration must show a minimum balance of HK\$10,000 (or equivalent amount in other currencies) for a student of CUHK Summer Institute.
(2b)	Electronic financial declaration is acceptable when it shows the name of the account holder, as well as the bank's name and logo.
(2c)	Financial declaration should be in English or Chinese.
(2d)	Financial declaration can be in the form of a monthly bank account statement (most recent) or certifying letter issued by the bank clearly stating the accumulative account balance.

- 3. Photocopies of identification and signature pages of parent's passport
