





- (1) Index of current economic conditions
- Base Value =76.55
- Index of 2008 = 81.55
- Variation in % between 2008 and 2002 = + 6.53%
- Quality of Life Index (Base Year) x (1+ Variation in %) =





(2) Housing affordability ratio

- Base Value = 4.68
- Index of 2008 = 7.67
- Variation in % between 2008 and 2002 = +63.89%
- Quality of Life Index (Base Year) x (1- Variation in %) =

Quality of Life Index in 2008= 4.76x(1-63.89%)=1.72





Nine (9) indicators improved in 2008:


2007-2008 Quality of Life Indices Better Indices
