The introduction of an internship programme for students of the Bachelor of Science Programme in Earth and Environmental Sciences with retroactive effect from January 2024 was approved.

The following recommendations of the relevant Boards of the Faculties for adoption of Pass/Failure grading with effect from 2024-25 were approved:

- (ii) for a course to be introduced by the Department of Social Work.

The recommendation of the Board of the Faculty of Science for a course to be introduced by the Bachelor of Science Programme in Earth and Environmental Sciences with effect from 2024-25 to adopt Distinction/Pass/Failure grading was approved.

The recommendation to revise the exemption criteria of two Faculty Package courses for Pharmacy students admitted in 2024-25 and thereafter with outstanding results in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education examination was approved.

The proposed revisions to the *Procedures for Handling Student Disciplinary Cases* were approved.

The proposed revisions to the following University regulations were approved:

- (i) General Regulations Governing Full-time Undergraduate Studies;
- (ii) Regulations Governing Undergraduate Medicine Programme;
- (iii) Regulations Governing Associate Students;
- (iv) Regulations on Students of the University;
- (v) General Regulations Governing Postgraduate Studies;
- (vi) General Regulations Governing Undergraduate Studies for Students admitted by The Chinese University of Hong Kong, Shenzhen (CUHK(SZ)); and
- (vii) General Regulations Governing Postgraduate Studies for Students admitted by CUHK(SZ).

The establishment of an Institute of Medical Intelligence and XR was endorsed for approval by the Council.

The consolidation of the Institute of Future Cities and the Institute of Space and Earth Information Science was endorsed for approval by the Council.

The recommendations of the Committee on Re-approval of Self-financed Taught Postgraduate Programmes on 13 self-financed taught postgraduate programmes were approved.

The proposed revisions to the compositions of the Senate Academic Planning Committee and of the Senate Committee on Language Enhancement were approved.

The 2022-23 annual reports from the following committees, supplemented by the verbal reports of the respective Chairpersons, were received:
